***NeuroMania, the Circus Style Show that Cheers Tijuana in Teatro Zaragoza***

- An evening filled with laughter and Healthy recreation was spent by attendees at the premiere of NeuroMania, the contemporary Circus show, with acrobats that came all the way from Las Vegas, Nevada.

Entire families with grandpas, parents, sons & grandchildren, arrived on time to enjoy the premiere of a unique circus show for the first time presented in the city: NeuroMania.

Teatro Zaragoza was the meeting point in which hundreds of Tijuana families recalled the golden age scenario where it once functioned as a permanent voluntary theater.

The newly renovated theater in the city received acrobats, dancers, gymnasts, clowns and juggler's former members of Cirque Du Soleil, a contemporary circus show that managed to take the applause of the audience from the first moment.

The first show was specially designed for children, with more fun events such as the presentation of funny clowns, who interacted with the audience and gave them giant colored balloons for the young viewers.

On the front row hosting the event, was Cesar Eduardo Hank Inzunza, Representative of the Institute of Culture of Baja California, Tijuana (ICBC), who with his family applauded each of the acts of the program. He also was accompanied by the President of the Council for Culture and the Arts of Nuevo León (CONARTE), MSc. Katzir Medina Meza and President of Mutual Center Zaragoza, Lic. Efrain Castillo Jesus Sarabia.

With NeuroMama, the activities of the 2014 October Festival in Tijuana have begun organized by the Institute of Culture of Baja California for 13 years throughout the State.

The show was brought to Mexico for the first time, thanks to a partnership between ICBC in coordination with the internet browser NeuroMama.com

### Teatro Zaragoza

In order to promote and strengthen cultural activities in Tijuana, last May, the General Director of the Institute of Culture of Baja California, Lic. Manuel Felipe Bejarano Giacomán delivered the restoration of the Teatro Zaragoza.

In the presence of Mr. Arvizu Loyola Gabriel, Chief of the Secretary of Infrastructure & Urban Development Zona Costa (SIDUE Tijuana-Rosarito Beach), project coordinator. Lic. Manuel Felipe Bejarano Giacomán handed the keys to building Chairman Zaragoza Meritorious Mutual Center Zaragoza, Lic. Efrain Castillo Sarabia.

The Zaragoza Theatre, located at the corner of 4th Street. Avenida Salvador Diaz Miron and "E" mutualismo, in the downtown area, it was the first theater in Tijuana. It was opened in 1944 and currently belongs to Meritorious Mutual Center Zaragoza.

In addition to theater performances in this landmark film screenings were held, highlighting silent films and feature films from the golden age of Mexican cinema.

After a period of approximately 25 years without activity, Zaragoza Theatre reopened its doors to the public for the benefit of residents on both sides of the border.

Now with circus NeuroManía, Teatro Zaragoza will host internationally renowned artists, emphasizing the variety of shows presented at this important stage.
